


## EMBERS BEAULIEU LOCATION & DIRECTIONS – HAMPSHIRE



### DIRECTIONS TO EMBERS BEAULIEU CAMPSITE, HAMPSHIRE – LOCATED ½ MILE FROM BEAULIEU, HAMPSHIRE

#### BY CAR

From London: Take the M3 south from Twickenham/Richmond or from junction 12 of the M25. After approximately 56 miles on the M3 take the left hand lanes at junction 13 following onto the M27 West towards Bournemouth. After 7 miles leave the M27 at junction 2 and turning left onto the A326 and follow signs to the Beaulieu National Motor Museum. After 9 miles take a right on to B3054 onto Beaulieu Road and enter the New Forest National Park. After 3 miles you reach Beaulieu Village – go through the village and turn left at the T Junction. After another half mile the campsite is on the right hand side at the Beaulieu Organic Farm Shop.

From East: Take the M27 towards Bournemouth. Leave the M27 at junction 2 and turning left onto the A326 and follow signs to the Beaulieu National Motor Museum. After 9 miles take a right on to B3054 onto Beaulieu Road and enter the New Forest National Park. After 3 miles you reach Beaulieu Village – go through the village and turn left at the T Junction. After another half mile the campsite is on the right hand side at the Beaulieu Organic Farm Shop.

From West: Take the A31 going east towards Southampton, which turns into the M27. Leave the M27 at junction 2 and turning right onto the A326 and follow signs to the Beaulieu National Motor Museum. After 9 miles take a right on to B3054 onto Beaulieu Road and enter the New Forest National Park. After 3 miles you reach Beaulieu Village – go through the village and turn left at the T Junction. After another half mile the campsite is on the right hand side at the Beaulieu Organic Farm Shop.

SAT NAV's - Enter **SO42 7WA** which takes you to **Hatchet Lane, Beaulieu**. We are based next to the Beaulieu Organic Farm Shop.

#### BY TRAIN

There is a regular train service from central London (Clapham Junction) taking approximately 1 ½ hours to Beaulieu Road Station, which is located about three miles from the campsite. Alternatively use Brockenhurst station, which has a more regular service, as your end destination for your journey.

#### CYCLING

Campers can take a train from central London (Clapham Junction) taking approximately 1 ½ hours to Beaulieu Road Station, which is located about three miles from the campsite. Alternatively use Brockenhurst station, which has a more regular service, as your end destination for your journey. It's a fairly open ride down Hatchet Lane (B3056) to Beaulieu. Once you reach Beaulieu, carry on with Hatchet lane. After another half mile the campsite is on the right hand side at the Beaulieu Organic Farm Shop. There are numerous other routes if you want to go "off road". As you can hire a tent from us, cyclists can carry their sleeping bags and any other camping gear in a backpack.

#### WALKING

For the more adventurous, you can walk for approximately 6 miles from Beaulieu Road Station on various tracks to Embers Beaulieu, located at the Beaulieu Organic Farm Shop, SO42 7WA. Use an ordnance survey map for your route, which can be found at [www.ordnancesurvey.co.uk](http://www.ordnancesurvey.co.uk). As you can hire a tent from us, walkers can carry their sleeping bags and any other camping gear in a backpack.

#### BUSES

Wilts & Dorset run a limited bus service between Hythe and Lymington on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday which drops visitors in Beaulieu Village. The campsite is a short walk away on Hatchet Lane at Beaulieu Organic Farm Shop.
